Reserve your spot as soon as possible as we can only take 8 students. Call or text Dawn Foerster @361-935-5613. Yummy snacks provided.

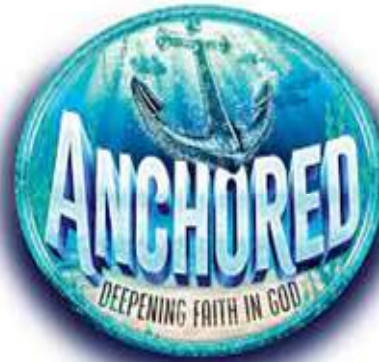
