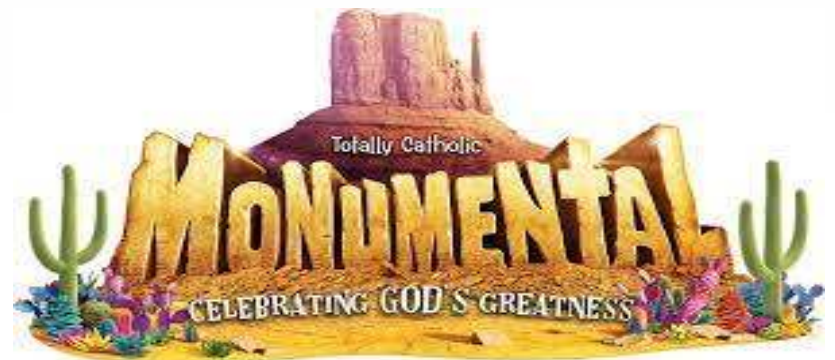

Locks will be removed on the exterior Choir door, exterior Kitchen door, double glass doors in Luther Hall, alley side doors in Luther Hall, ally side door adjacent the Acolyte Room and the door at end of hall near the Chapel. The lock will also be removed in the door to the outside stairwell in the Education Building. All these doors have panic hardware that allows access to the outside.  
Security cameras will be installed in several places inside education wing and Luther Hall.

The Trinity Security Team has requested the following changes to our building entrances due to numerous

instances where schools, churches and large gatherings have been targeted by persons intent on doing harm. The Congregational Council approved these changes on June 13, 2022. Thankfully we have not experienced any problems. The intent is not to cause inconvenience to anyone, but rather seeks to provide a degree of security to our members. This policy will hopefully be temporary and will not be 100% effective in every situation. Possibly, these measures may buy time for members to take action .

The following is the policy:

Congregational president Security Policy for Entrances  
There will be only one entrance to the Education building, which is the double glass doors on DeLeon Street. All other doors are to remain locked. Once inside, you may exit the other doors but make sure they are closed and locked. You may open doors long enough to bring in food, etc., but close immediately. If someone knocks on the door and you recognize them, you may let them in. The Sanctuary doors will be opened once personnel are located at these doors. These doors will be locked ten minutes after church service begins. At least one council member will remain in Narthex in case someone arrives late. A viewing site glass will be
